

Local Rule Concerning Bunkers During Covid

Since rakes are not in bunkers, footprints are left unattended and an unfair lie can be created for the player. A new local rule has been approved by the Proshop and states that a ball anywhere in a bunker may be lifted and placed within one foot of where the ball lies, no closer to the hole.

The ball may also be cleaned, USGA allows any lifted (free drop) ball to be cleaned.

The bunker should then be foot raked, best as possible.

As per previous a USGA rule change, the ball may be removed from the bunker, placed no closer to the hole on a line from the hole to where the ball came to rest in the bunker, for a 2-stroke penalty.
