

## VIEWPOINT LADIES NINE HOLE CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP

Revised February 2015

To play in the Club Championship rounds, a member must:

- have played in a minimum of three league matches during the season
- pay the tournament entry fee
- have an established handicap
- sign up and play in at least two of the three league championship rounds

Dates of the Club Championship Tournament rounds are identified by the Club. Three rounds will be played with only the two best scores used. In case of bad weather, an alternative date will be set.

Handicaps will be "frozen" on the Saturday prior to the first round of the Club Championship. Flights will be determined according to members' indexes.

There will be two Club Champions – the low gross champion and the low net champion. The executive board will decide on flight winners. Suggested is three gross and three net per flight.

In case of a tie in either the low gross champion or the low net champion, there will be a playoff of the entire nine holes during the next league play. If there remains a tie, the scorecard method will be used. Comparisons of the scores of the 9<sup>th</sup> hole, then the 8<sup>th</sup> hole, 7<sup>th</sup> hole, etc. until a winner can be identified.

If there is a tie in a flight, the third round of score will be compared. If there is still a tie, the scorecard method will be used. Comparisons of the scores of the 9<sup>th</sup> hole, then the 8<sup>th</sup> hole, 7<sup>th</sup> hole, etc. until a winner can be identified.
