Ladies 9-Hole League Championship Information 2024 / 2025 League Season

All Players need to sign-up online to play Feb 4th, 11th, 18th & Feb 25th Signup Deadline 12:00PM Friday before League Day

League Championship Participants will be scheduled Tee Times with players who have similar handicaps.

Note: League play continues for members that choose not to play in the Championship Tournament

Members not registered for Championship play will be scheduled a Tee-time after League Championship Participants Tee Times.

Championship Tournament Dates: Feb 4th, 11th & 18th

Scores from two of the three League Championship golf days will be used for championship scores –Alternate date (Feb 25th) will only be used if Feb 4th, 11th or 18th is canceled due to inclement weather.

If a member is only able to play 2 of the 3 playoff days, those 2 rounds will be used for Championship scores

Members will be notified by email if weather conditions are either unsafe or undesirable for play by the Executive Team & the ProShop will be notified.

Tournament Fees: \$5.00 registration fee

Registration Date: January 1 – 30th

Championship Requirements:

- 1. Be a member of the 9-Hole league.
- 2. Pay the tournament entry fee (\$5.00)
- 3. Have an established handicap for the VP Ladies 9-Hole League.
- 4. Sign up on-line and play in at least two of the three League Championship days.

Championship Rules:

- Players must play out each hole tee to cup. All strokes count.
 DO NOT STOP AT 10.
- 2. Handicaps are "frozen" the Saturday prior to the first round of tournament play.
- 3. Members will be placed into one of the 3 Flights (A, B or C) as determined by the ProShop according to members' index.

Championship Winners

- 1. An Overall Champion will be awarded for "Low Gross" and "Low Net."
 - In case of a tie in either the overall Low Gross Champion or the Low Net Champion, there will be a playoff of the entire nine holes during the next league play. If there remains a tie, the scorecard method will be used. Comparison of the scores of the 9th hole, then the 8th hole, 7th hole...until a winner is determined.
- 2. In addition to an Overall Champion, each Flight (A, B & C) will be awarded 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place Champion for "Low Gross" and "Low Net."
 - The Overall Champion does not qualify for any of the Flight Champion awards.
 - If there is a tie in a flight, the best round of score for each player will be compared. If there is still a tie, the scorecard method (as above), will be used to compare the best round score of each person.

The ProShop along with representation from the League Executive Team will decide the Champions and flight winners.
